ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE USE OF GAS POWERED RECREATIONAL VEHICLES WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES; REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CARLTON LANDING, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1.

(a) Definition. As used in this section:

(1) "Gas Powered Recreational Vehicle" shall mean any vehicle powered by an internal combustion engine, designed for recreational or sport purposes, that is not permitted to be operated on a public highway by provisions of the Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

(b) No personal shall operate a Gas Powered Recreational Vehicle upon paved or unpaved streets or alleys or pedestrian ways within the Town Boundaries.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

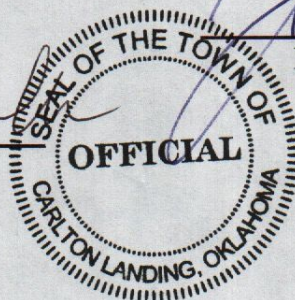
SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions.
